



Another Great Year for CBR / Pro Life on Campus

Some days, I have to admit, I can get a bit discouraged. How can we visit more schools? How can we get more people to help? How can we make people understand how regular giving (even \$10/month) changes everything? But the Thanksgiving holiday gave me time to reflect on God's provision and be reminded of Who's in charge here, anyway.

At CBR / Pro Life on Campus, we have so much to be thankful for. By God's grace and your faithful support, we've had an amazing year:

- Nationally, we took our GAP project to 22 schools around the country, reaching *upwards of half a million students*.
- Through our various conferences and training programs, *we trained hundreds of students — the next generation of pro-life leaders — in pro-life activism*.
- We drove our truth trucks in the districts of 14 Blue Dog Congressmen who voted for ObamaCare. *Come January, all but 2 will be out of the Congress*.
- We forged strategic partnerships with other pro-life organizations like Georgia Right to Life (GRTL), and Deeper Still, a post-abortion healing ministry. *GRTL is actively using CBR photos to educate Georgians about abortion*. Deeper Still is helping us reach hurting women with hope and healing through our Messiah Jesus.
- Through our new Facebook page (www.facebook.com/ProLifeOnCampus), we are reaching a worldwide audience with helpful information for pro-life activists.
- Our *Celebrating Life* event, to be held February 14 at the Knoxville Convention Center, promises to be a huge event. *Gov. Mike Huckabee will be speaking*. GAP Strikes Gold at UNC Charlotte

Your investment is paying off big-time! If you list the most active pro-life student groups in the country, you'll find that many of them were started by CBR Southeast ... U of Maryland, U of North Carolina, U of Kentucky, U of Louisville, Middle Tennessee State U, just to name a few. Add one more: UNC-Charlotte (UNCC). Along with our friends at Life Advocates in North Carolina, we helped pro-life students hit the ground running. We are so pleased at the great work they are doing. We took GAP to UNCC in April.

Every day is a great day when you're doing God's work. A grandmother taking classes at UNCC asked our White House volunteer Kathy Hardin for some extra brochures. (Kathy is from White House, Tennessee ... not DC, for all you people in Rio Linda.) She said her granddaughter had gotten pregnant and considered abortion but the grandmother told her not to do it if she expected any help from her. The granddaughter is now 5 months along and keeps asking if she did the wrong thing by keeping the baby. The grandmother said, "I want some pictures to show her what '**the wrong thing**' is!" The next day the grandmother returned and asked for more brochures to show to the teens at her church; she said everyone else pretends like none of them ever have abortions. She said she wished she could bring everyone to see the pictures.

While the GAP display was set up at the Belk Tower in the middle of campus, our truth truck, "Choice" signs, and educational brochure helped us project pro-life power (the power of the pictures) far beyond the display itself. Both days during lunchtime, the Students for Life and the Hardin children (Caleb and Abigail) took four "Choice" signs and hundreds of our "How can you compare abortion to genocide?" photo-brochures down to the Student Center. At the same time, our truth truck was circling the campus. One student walked out of the Student Center, saw the signs and the trucks and the brochures and exclaimed, with a mixture of disgust and admiration, "***They're everywhere!***" Which is exactly where we want to be, by God's grace and with your help.

Pro-Life Training Academy

We are pleased to be training the next generation of pro-life activists through our new Pro-Life Training Academy (PLTA). The PLTA mission is two-fold:

- Train college and high-school students to articulate and respectfully defend the pro-life position.
- Bring together pro-lifers in any community together for the common purposes of education, preparation, and outreach.

Our first two Academies were in Kennesaw and Athens, Georgia. Faculty included Fletcher Armstrong of CBR and Toby Tatum of Georgia Right to Life. Role-playing prepared students for real encounters. GAP events at Kennesaw State U and the U of Georgia provided "on-the-job" training.
