#### Why Liberty University?

They didn't like seeing pictures of abortion at Liberty University (LU) last Fall. But all the while, we believed it was the most important Genocide Awareness Project (GAP) deployment in the history of CBR.

Christian young people are having abortions in staggering numbers. In fact, 1 in 5 women who abort their babies identify themselves as "born again" or "evangelical" Christians. They are having abortions because they are just as ignorant about abortion as everyone else. How could they not be ignorant, when Christian leaders believe it's somebody else's problem?

The students asked, over and over, "Why are you here? We are already pro-life!" We answered with our own question, "Then what are you doing about it?" All week long, our plea for help was met with blank stares. *It had not occurred to them that they should personally do something to stop abortion.*
